Things you need to know before you jump...

- There is a registration fee of \$309 per person (normally \$359).
- Full payment is required to Guide Dogs WA to hold your place by 2 April 2017, who in turn pay Skydive Australia in one payment for all skydivers.
- All jumpers are required to sign the Australian Parachuting Federation forms. These forms are available online. Participants will be sent a link in which they can complete these forms before the time comes for their jump.
- You will be required to fundraise a minimum of \$750 to participate. Once your registration is complete, we'll send you a link to set up your personal online fundraising page and help you smash your fundraising goal!
- Skydivers will be jumping securely harnessed to their tandem instructor and will board the plane in small groups.
- We recommend that you dress in layers, in casual, comfortable clothing, with running shoes. You will be provided with skydiving pants to wear over your clothes for your jump (if you are interested in dressing up – please liaise with Lauren to check your costume/idea will not interfere with the safety of your jump).
- Skydive Australia will provide you with a designated check in time. We will do our best to accommodate preferred times.
- Make a day of it! Bring along your own personal support crew and a picnic to help you celebrate your achievement! Your furry friend is also welcomed as dogs are permitted in the park and on the beach!
- Every effort will be made to ensure your jump occurs in the quickest possible time frame without compromising safety.
- Weather conditions, air traffic and road traffic may all have an influence on jump times and the landing area.
- Participants who weigh over 110kg are subject to Tandem Master assessment and surcharges apply if you weigh over 95kg.
- All participants must be over 12 years of age and a guardian must be present if you are under 18.
- No drugs or alcohol are to be consumed eight hours before your tandem skydive.
- No scuba diving can occur 24 hours before your tandem skydive.
- Any medical conditions should be discussed with Skydive Australia before booking and may require evaluation by a Medical Practitioner or their instructional staff.
- Participants check in at Kent Street, Rockingham where you will be briefed before boarding a bus to the drop zone to watch the previous group land. You'll then jump back on the bus and travel approximately 25 minutes to Murrayfield where you'll board the plane, take the plunge and land back at the drop zone in Rockingham. Return transfers to Kent Street will be provided by bus.
- Filming and photography packages are available for an additional fee of \$139-\$199 and can be purchased on the day.
