



Guide and Assistance Dogs

Access Rights



By law, Guide and Assistance Dogs are allowed access to everywhere their handler goes – and this includes dogs in training.

It is an offence to refuse entry to a person accompanied by a Guide or Assistance Dog, including dogs in training.

It is important **not to pat, feed or talk** to a Guide or Assistance Dog or dog in training, especially when they are in harness or coat.

The only exceptions are operating theatres and some areas of zoos (such as the walk-through exhibits).
